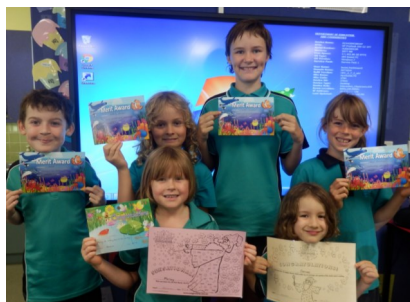
Library - next Tuesday will be the last borrowing day for the term, as the library gets a tidy-up in week 11.
