We would like to thank everyone for the wonderful support for our school in collecting vouchers. We are not sure of the final tally yet but the numbers are looking great!

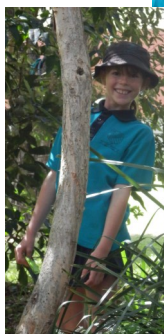


Life Education Reminder
