Attendance Reward Day Term 4

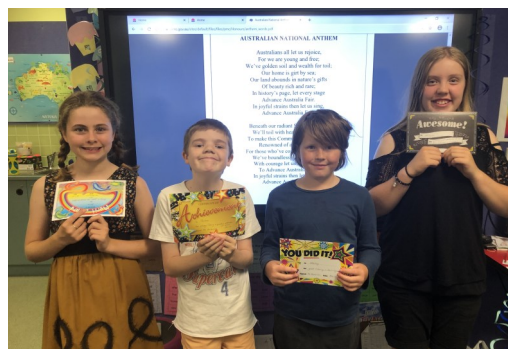

SCHOOL BANKING



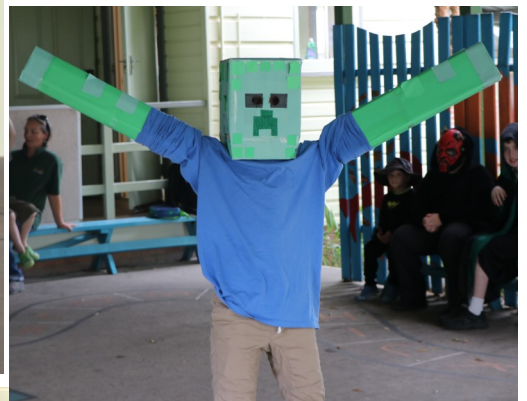
Next banking date is: **Wednesday 9 December**
